PRESCHOOL INFORMATION

We have space for 32 children at Weston Favell CE Preschool

We offer the following sessions:

- Full time Monday to Friday 8.30am to 3.30pm
- Morning sessions 8.30 am to 11.30am
- Afternoon sessions 12.30pm to 3.30pm

Children are invited to stay all day if they bring a packed lunch and pay £3 per day for the extra lunch hour. Should you wish to use your 30 extended hours funding to pay for the lunch hour for the week, then you may do this, but your child would need to be collected from Preschool at 11.30pm on Fridays.

Deadlines for all application to be considered are as follows:

September Start Date – All applications to be received by 31st March. January Start Date – All applications to be received by 31st August. April Start Date – All applications to be received by 31st December.

Please note start dates for pupils are the term following their 3rd birthday.

All applications received by the deadlines will be considered and allocated via our admission criteria, which can be found on our school website. Confirmation of allocation following your application will be after the deadline dates have passed. We will acknowledge and confirm receipt of your application form.

Places are available starting the term after your child's third birthday and we offer the government-funded entitlement of 15 hours free childcare each week during term time, (Universal Funding). You may also be entitled to an extra 15 hours of free childcare per week (Extended Hours Funding). Please follow the link below to check your entitlement.

If you are not entitled to Extended Hours Funding but would like your child to attend more than 15 hours per week, you can pay for the additional sessions at a cost of £15 per session provided that there are sessions available.
