# Reading Journey



## Introduction

Our Reading Journey maps the texts that children will encounter during their time at Weston Favell CE Primary School.

"One of the most important topics in teaching reading is text selection, the process by which teachers choose what their students will read," (Lemov, 2016).


Having texts mapped for each year group from Reception to Year 6 ensures that children encounter quality texts, with appropriate challenge and of a range of genres throughout their time at primary school. It also makes certain that texts are not repeated unnecessarily – although there are links to retrieve previous learning – and allows for progression. These texts have been carefully selected to ensure that children are exposed to high quality texts, with a range of themes, to broaden their knowledge of their world and to help them to develop culturally, emotionally, intellectually, socially and spiritually.

**Core texts:** These are high quality, engaging texts to be used as a stimulus for English planning sequences. Children will be exposed to extracts from this text and it will usually form the basis of their writing. This would normally be one text per unit, although teachers may choose other texts to complement or supplement this, particularly where the text is limited.


Linked texts: These are additional texts that will be used to supplement children's knowledge and understanding of the core text or the wider curriculum. This includes genres different to the core text including information texts, plays, poetry, recipes, instructions etc. These texts are encountered through the direct teaching of reading, part of wider curriculum reading loads and through reading for pleasure, such as in the reading area or shared as part of 'story-time'. These may vary according to the specific class's interests and needs.

Class Readers: These are texts recommended for each year group to use in their 'story-time' sessions. These will be read aloud by the class teacher and therefore may be above the independent reading abilities of the class. The Reading Journey provides suggestions however these are not set in stone, for new, quality books are being published all the time and newer recommendations should be embraced. The children's interests and requests are valued too.


